

Blue Grass Airport Operations Internship Program

The Airport Operations Internship Program at Blue Grass Airport was created in partnership with the Eastern Kentucky University Aviation Program and the EKU Career and Co-Op Office in the fall of 2013 to give EKU Aviation students real-world aviation experience while reinforcing classroom knowledge, enhancing basic career skills, and earning academic credit towards their degree.



Available exclusively to EKU students and one of only a few of its kind in the United States, the program is offered to students twice each academic year by applying through the Career and Co-Op Office.

Internship Program Overview

Students who participate in the program can expect to gain experience in each of the following areas:

- Airport communications/emergency dispatch
- FAR Part 139/airfield Inspections
- Airport security and access control
- Airport badging and personnel training
- Airfield, markings, signage, and lighting
- Airport administration, maintenance, finance, and marketing
- Aviation career preparation



Schedule

The internship program is offered twice during the course of each academic year. Each internship period coincides with the below academic terms:

Spring Internship	January - August	Spring/Summer Academic Terms
Fall Internship	August - January	Fall/Winter Academic Terms

Requirements

- Junior, Senior, or Graduate student, currently enrolled in the Eastern Kentucky University Aviation program. A major or minor in Aviation Management is required.
- Possess a 3.0 grade point average (GPA) or greater on a 4.0 scale at the of application submission.
- Valid driver's license
- General knowledge of purpose and activity of airports
- Ability to fulfill the 20 hrs/wk for the duration of the assigned internship period
- Successfully pass a criminal history background check
- Complete a summary essay at the conclusion of the internship
- Possess the following skills and abilities
 - Communication • Analytical
 - Problem Solving • Computer
 - Customer Service • Time Management
 - Project Management • Multi-tasking
